We went 2 and 3 in Dual meets and had over 160 improved times at Champs. It looks like we had two all-time records broken: Arianna Tomasello in the 15-18 50 Breastroke 33.97 and Skyler Smith with a 20.68 in the 8u 25 Breastroke. You can see what stroke the strength of our team is. I am proud of each and every swimmer on the team; great job by everyone.

The Champs meet was one of the most efficiently run meets I have ever been involved with. The parent reps and Volunteers should be commended. Every aspect from hospitality, to officiating, to Marshalls, was done well. Excellent job, thank your parent reps and volunteers.

Our competition is tough. Santa Teresa and Shadowbrook run year round teams out of their cabana pools. Almaden has some of Quicksilver's fast swimmers. The point scorers for Crossgates and Pinehurst are year round swimmers. I was very proud of our team because we had a significant number of point scoring swimmers that do not swim year round. That being said, it is important to swim year round with a quality coach that will help technique, endurance, and set up the team very well for next year. Quicksilver will continue dialogue about a bid for the Creekside pool, although there are numerous issues to be worked out and nothing is imminent. Meet The Interns


